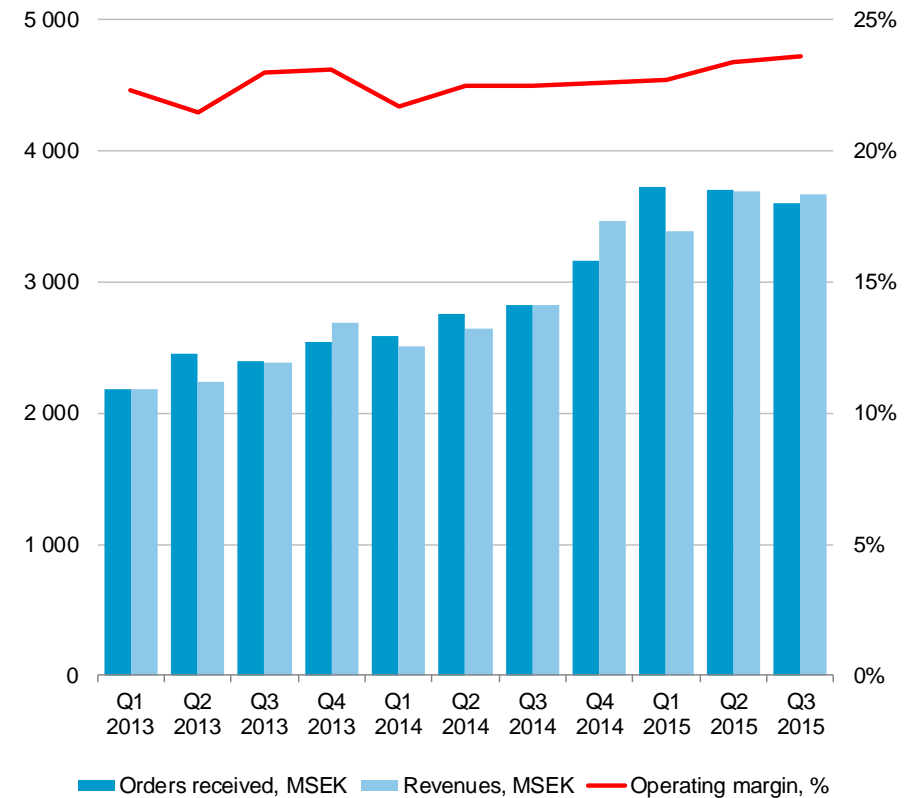

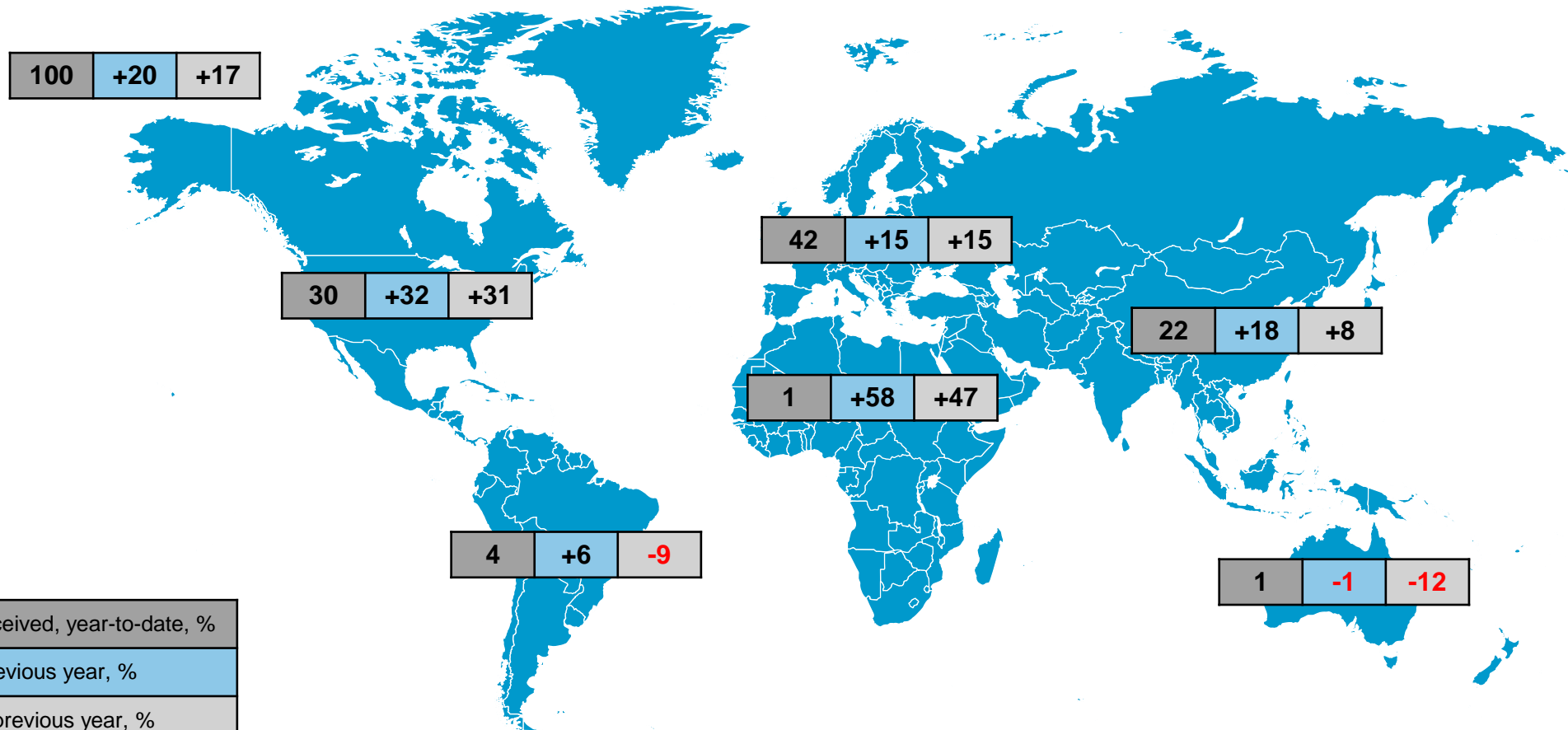
Orders, revenues and operating margin
